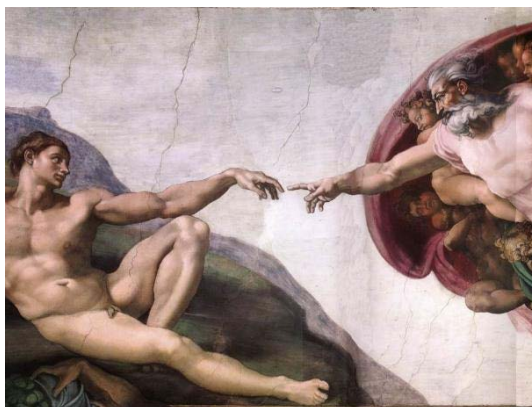

**Vatican Museums**

Today it is the Vatican Day! You will meet your private driver at your hotel and he will be at your disposal to take you to the Entrance of Vatican Museums.

This tour with an expert English speaking guide will start from the Pine-Cone Courtyard which takes the name from the bronze pine-cone set into the "nicchione" and it was an ancient Roman fountain. You will proceed the tour visiting the Pio-Clementino Museum where we will admire the Belvedere Octagonal Court that houses the statues of Laocoon and Apollo, the Room of the Muses with statue of Belvedere Torso, the Rotunda Room where you will find the bust of Jupiter, the colossal gilded bronze statue of Hercules and the monolithic porphyry basin, found in the ruins of the Nero's Golden House, the Greek Cross Room with the sarcophagus of Constantina, the Emperor Constatine's daughter, and that of Saint Helena, the Emperor Constantine's mother. The itinerary inside the Vatican Museums will carry on with the visit of the Gallery of the Candelabre, the Gallery of Tapestries and the Gallery of Maps and from these Galleries you will enter directly in the Raphael Rooms, where you will observe the extraordinary frescoes executed by Raphael and his pupil for the Julius II's Apartments, and The Sistine Chapel, famous all over the world for the breathtaking Michelangelo's ceiling and the Last Judgment.

## **Ancient Rome**

Meet your expert English speaking guide and your Driver at the Hotel and start the tour from the Roman Forum, the main square of Rome, and you will take a pleasant stroll crossing the Via Sacra (Sacred Way, the most important street in ancient Rome along which victorious general rode in triumphant procession) where you will be able to see the ruins of some marvelous Ancient Monuments built during the History of Ancient Rome. You will admire the Triumphal Arches of Titus and Septimius Severus, the Curia, seat of the Roman Senate, the Basilica Emilia and the Basilica Julia, used both for business transactions, the Vesta's Temple with the House of the Vestal Virgins, and the Temples of Antoninus and Faustina, Vespasian and Saturn. You will proceed the tour along the Palatine Hill, where you will see the ruins of the Domitian's Palace and his private Stadium, and from the top of hill you could observe an unforgettable view over the valley of the Circus Maximus, the famous circus built for the chariot races. At the end of the tour you will be in Colosseum where, jumping the queues, you will be able to enter in the magnificent Flavian Amphitheatre and admire where the gladiatorial duels, wild beast fights and naval battles were arranged for the entertainment of Roman people.

### **Florence Highlights**

A visit to Florence (Firenze) is a must for any art lover. UNESCO estimates that 60% of the world's most important artworks are in Italy, with over half of them located in Florence. Situated in the northwest of Italy, surrounded by the wine-growing hills of Chianti, the city attracts rapture and frustration in equal proportions. Few can dismiss the image of Brunelleschi's cathedral dome bursting through the morning mist – a terracotta balloon hovering above the medieval rooftops. But once the visitor drops down to street level, the profusion of traffic, tourists and touts can remove all sense of tranquillity. It seems every building holds a masterpiece, demanding attention and often gobbling up funds. The streets are narrow and dark, enclosed on either side by granite palaces and even the open spaces are crowded with babbling tour groups.

Spend your day in Florence in the historic center, beginning at the Battistero, where you'll find Ghiberti's bronze doors. Next, head for the Duomo with its majestic cupola, designed by Brunelleschi and later used as a model for the dome of St. Peter's in Rome. Giotto's Campanile, next to the Duomo, is worth a brief visit. Stroll down Via dei Calzaiuoli to Piazza della Signoria, where you should stop for an espresso and pastry or, if you're hungry, a cold drink and panino (small sandwich). Now enter the Galleria degli Uffizi, home to Botticelli's mystical Birth of Venus, as well as works by Giotto, Michelangelo, and Raphael. (Arrange for tickets at the Uffizi ahead of time to avoid waiting on line.) When you leave the Uffizi, you should be ready to enjoy a full, leisurely, Italian-style meal at one of the city's fine restaurants. Spend the evening wandering the cobbled streets, shopping, and soaking up the atmosphere. Stop for another espresso, or perhaps a Sambuca, and retire to your hotel early.



### **Half day walking guided tour**

The tour includes the Academy Gallery, which keeps also the Michelangelo's "David", perhaps the greatest sculpture ever created, the gothic church of Santa Croce: here you will visit the tombs of Michelangelo, Galileo, Machiavelli, and marvel at the art works of Donatello and Giotto. With a short walk you will reach Piazza della Signoria, the center of Florentine politics and home to a captivating outdoor sculpture gallery. Shopping, architecture and history will collide in your mind as you will stroll over the Ponte Vecchio. The day will culminate at the Uffizi Gallery, where you will concentrate on select masterpieces of Giotto, Botticelli, Raphael, da Vinci and Michelangelo.
